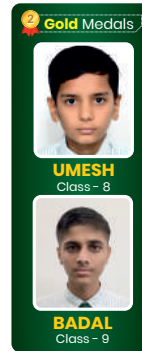

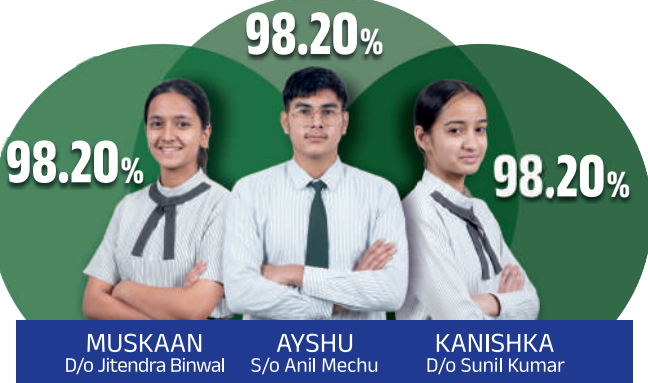

In today's hyper-connected world, Myriad is more than a word; it is a lens through which we view the complexity of modern life. It captures the constant stream of digital notifications that pull us in countless directions. This word invites us to see the world as a kaleidoscope rather than a simple list. By using "myriad," we honour the truth that life's most meaningful things—from digital footprints to our deepest emotions—are simply too vast to be counted.

Did You Know?

In Ancient Greece, "myriad" was the literal number 10,000 before evolving to mean any countless amount. It was so significant that it had its own symbol (Μ) to represent ten thousand.



The word "myriad" bridges the finite and the infinite, turning a number into a symbol of overwhelming complexity. Philosophers used it to describe the "myriad" things—the endless diversity of the physical world arising from a single source.

For poets, it evokes the sublime—the feeling of being pleasantly humbled by the vastness of the universe, whether describing a myriad of stars or countless flickers of light on the sea.

In *The Forest of Enchantments* by Chitra Banerjee Divakaruni, "myriad" describes how Sita navigates the countless versions of duty (dharma) and the many expectations placed upon her as a princess, wife, and woman. It also reflects the myriad joys and sorrows that shape her voice.
